Frequently Asked Questions



Q- Does our Patrol have to make a flag and a cheer?

A- No, but it will cost you points.

Q- Can one adult be responsible for several Scouts?

A- Two-deep leadership at all times.

Q- If we are only visiting for the day, must there be an adult for each Scout and must the adult register?

A- Two-deep leadership at all times. One registered adult for every 5 Scouts.

Q- What if I'm not sure which parent will be attending with the Webelos Scout when filling in the registration form?

A- Put down either one, our concern is that at least one parent makes a commitment to camping with the Scout.

Q- What gear should I bring?

A- Read your Information packet.

Q- Does the registration fee cover both the Scout and adult?

A- No, this is a per person fee.

Q- Can our Den Chief attend?

A- Only if he is on staff.

Q- Where will we sleep?

A- Each group will be assigned a campsite within the camp. No Motor homes.

Q- When we arrive, can we drive directly to the campsite?

A- No. You must check-in with registration to see where your group will be camping

Q- Will there be any organized activities Friday night?

A- Yes, there will be a concert by a local youth band called NO Parking Zone at 7:30pm.

Q- My scout's Unit is not going, can I still bring my scout?

A- Yes, we can put the scout with another patrol for the weekend.

Q- Do we have to register as a group?

A- Please register as a Den, Pack or Troop, not individually (unless you are the only one).

Q- Can I bring my pet?

A- No, it is against camp policy.

Q- Can I bring my scouts siblings?

A- Yes, but they are your responsibility and would need to stay with you. You would need to pay the adult registration fee for them for insurance purposes and they would not be participating in the activities.

Q- Can we buy meals on site?

A- Yes, but they cost more money. See the "registration form" for more details.

Q- Will the scouts be earning any awards?

A- There are competition awards but not advancement awards.
